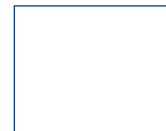

These are some of the many services that the Clinton Rotary Club supports:

**Families Helping Families** – is an all volunteer organization that is dedicated to helping Clinton families that are in need of assistance with funds to help defray the cost of heating and electric bills, and food for those in need.

**Other Local Organizations** – The Club supplies manpower and funds for Helping Hands, which offers necessities baskets and general assistance to local families displaced by fire, flood or other disasters. Also, the club assists at benefit dinners, blood drives, and other projects held by local civic organizations, including the Clinton Volunteer Fire Department, the Clinton Chamber of Commerce, and the Shoreline Soup Pantry.

**Shoreline Soup Kitchen** – Home-made meals are provided four times a year at the local soup kitchen for needy families. The Club supplies all food and kitchen help and serves up to 30 people at each dinner.

**Interact** – The Rotary sponsors The Interact Club at The Morgan School, assisting the high school students with funds and support of their projects. The Club also sends Interact members to various statewide seminars and to participate in international humanitarian efforts.

**Scholarships** – Four scholarships are awarded annually to local students who wish to further their education. One of the scholarships, named after founding member Vincent Lupone, is given to an Interact member.

**Dictionary Project** – Dictionaries are provided at no cost to all third grade students in Clinton and Killingworth.

**Liberty Food Bank** – The Rotary Club and Liberty Bank combine efforts to raise funds for the local soup pantry during November for the holidays. Liberty Bank increases deposited donations by 50 cents on each dollar.

**AMBER Alert** – Child identification program registering children under the age of 18 into the National Data Base, which is conducted throughout the year during many local and statewide events including the Connecticut Marine Trades Association Boat Show, and the Big E in Springfield, MA.

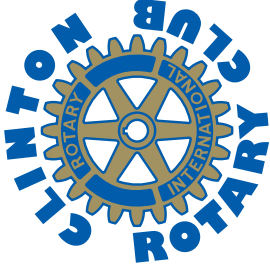

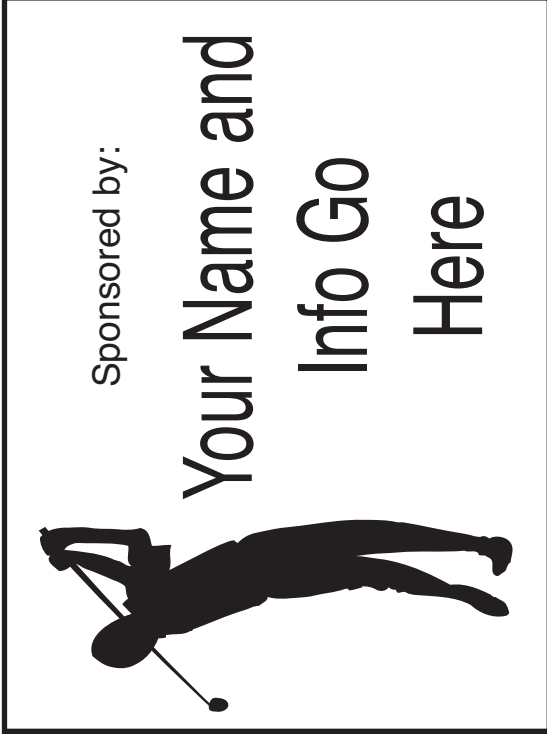
